11:05 a.m. This is the time set for status conference. The Motion to Supplement the Record, doc. 505, is discussed. The Court will require the power point presentations used by counsel and Mr. Stockdell to be filed as part of the record. The Motion to Supplement the Record [**doc. 505**] is granted.

Defendant's Motion to Supplement the Record in Support of its Motion for Summary Judgment, doc. 540, and Plaintiff's Motion to Strike, doc. 554, are discussed. The Motion to Strike [**doc. 554**] is denied summarily. Defendant's Motion to Supplement [**doc. 540**] is granted, to the extent that the facts supplied there may be added to the record. The Court finds it is of no legal consequence as to the pending motion for summary judgment by USAPA and the Plaintiff need not address it.

The 2nd Discovery Dispute, doc. 550, is discussed. The Court is not disposed to rule on this issue without further research and briefing. The 3rd Discovery Dispute, doc. 551, is discussed.

Trial schedule is discussed. The Motion to Continue Trial and Discovery Deadlines, **doc. 556** is discussed and granted. The Court grants a stipulated request for stay of discovery on damages until the pending motion for summary judgment is ruled on. The Court hereby continues the damages trial from August 11 to **January 19, 2010 at 9:00 a.m., counsel at 8:45 a.m.** **THE COURT ORDERS** counsel to submit within 10 days after the court rules on the summary judgment motion either joint or separate schedules for the completion of discovery based on the January 19, 2010 trial date. Any subpoenas already issued will continue in full force and effect.
