### Business Summary

**CORPORATE OVERVIEW.** On September 27, 2005, US Airways Group, Inc. was formed by merging the former US Airways Group, which was operating under Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection, with America West Holdings. America West was the surviving company in the merger, and adopted the US Airways name upon completion of the transaction.

As a result of the merger, LCC is the fifth largest airline operating in the U.S. as measured by domestic revenue passenger miles and available seat miles. The company has primary hubs in Charlotte, Philadelphia and Phoenix, with secondary hubs/focus cities in Las Vegas, New York, Washington D.C. and Boston. The company's strategy is to operate as a national low cost hub-and-spoke network carrier, providing service to about 215 airports in the continental U.S., Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, Latin America and Europe. The combined carrier operated a mainline fleet of 339 planes as of December 31, 2010, down from a total of 419 mainline planes operated by both airlines at the beginning of 2005. In addition, passengers are fed into the mainline system by a regional fleet consisting of 236 regional jets and 60 turboprops.

**CORPORATE STRATEGY.** LCC considers itself to be the largest U.S. low-cost carrier as measured by revenue passenger miles, and it also thinks it is the first low-cost carrier with a truly national presence across the U.S., as well as the only low-cost carrier with a significant international presence. At the same time, LCC believes it offers services that are not typically offered by low-cost carriers, including a global frequent flyer program, assigned seating, a first-class cabin, the US Airways Shuttle. A total of over 1,077 global destinations available through the company's membership in the Star Alliance, and a global airline alliance whose members include Air Canada, Lufthansa, Continental and United Airlines, among others.
