Paul Rice, to hand-deliver to your Tempe, Ariz., office on Wednesday, December 19, 2007, the award of the ALPA arbitration board "in the matter of the seniority integration of The Pilots of US Airways, Inc. and The Pilots of America West Airlines, Inc."

The award will be presented in accordance with section IV.A. of the ALPA/US Airways Transition Agreement and ALPA Merger Policy. As you know, the Transition Agreement, as well as ALPA Merger Policy, provides that no airline party may use the award until the negotiation and implementation of a single collective bargaining agreement. Such agreement will include appropriate negotiated terms for implementation of the award.
