THIS MATTER IS BEFORE THE COURT on the “Motion To Withdraw As Counsel For Courtney Borman” (Document No. 82) filed December 1, 2015. This motion has been referred to the undersigned Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b), and immediate review is appropriate. Having carefully considered the motion and the record, and noting consent of Plaintiffs’ counsel, the undersigned will grant the motion.

Defendant Borman's current counsel, Christopher M. Vann, reports that Defendant Borman consents to the discharge of Mr. Vann and his firm, and that Defendant Borman intends to use the services of Seham, Seham, Metz & Petersen, LLP. (Document No. 82, p.2). However, Mr. Vann's motion does not include Defendant Borman's last known address as required by Local Rule 83.1 (F).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the "Motion To Withdraw As Counsel For Courtney Borman" (Document No. 82) is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Christopher M. Vann shall provide the Clerk of Court with Defendant Borman's last known address by **December 4, 2015**. Christopher M. Vann and the Vann Law Firm, P.A. shall be excused from further representation of Defendant Borman in this matter after providing his address.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant Courtney Borman shall have up to and including **December 31, 2015** to answer or otherwise respond to Plaintiffs' Complaint.
