Plaintiffs seek leave to exceed the page limit set forth in the Court’s October 25, 2013 Order. (Doc. 271). USAPA opposes the motion but offers the alternative of granting the motion, increasing the page limit applicable to its reply, and extending the deadline for filing the reply. (Doc. 272). Plaintiffs oppose any extension of USAPA’s reply deadline.

There is no good solution. Plaintiffs should have complied with the previously established page-limit. But striking the response and ordering them to redo the brief would only prolong matters and further increase litigation costs. As for USAPA, it seems doubtful that it needs a full extra day to craft an additional page for its reply. But, on balance, granting the page extensions and granting USAPA one extra day is the best bad option.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED the Motion to Exceed Page Limitation (**Doc. 271**) is **GRANTED**.
