Intervenor US Airways, Inc. requests the court correct the judgment to conform to the technical requirement of Rule 23(c)(3). US Airways, Inc. also requests the Court remove a footnote from the January 10, 2014 Order. (Doc. 300). Plaintiffs do not oppose either request, except they argue the Court should make clear that removal of the footnote does not mean USAPA can “continue to represent US Airways pilots after [USAPA] is no longer the certified bargaining representative.” (Doc. 302 at 1). As for USAPA, it also believes both requests should be granted but it argues the Court should delete more than just a footnote. The additional portions USAPA would like to see deleted are, according to USAPA, “erroneous as matters of law and fact.” (Doc. 301 at 5). While that may be the case, those portions are directly attributable to USAPA’s arguments and positions in this case. In other words, to the extent USAPA does not like those statements, it should not have pressed the Court to adopt a view of the law that required them.

In light of the history of this case, and the parties’ continued disagreements about the


1 scope of the Court’s Order, the footnote will not be deleted.

2 Accordingly,

3 **IT IS ORDERED** the Motion to Amend (**Doc. 300**) is **GRANTED** to the extent the
4 judgment entered on January 10, 2014 (Doc. 299) is **AMENDED** to reflect that the judgment
5 applies to the certified West Pilot Class as defined in the Court’s September 18, 2013 Order:
6 “All pilots who are on the America West seniority list currently incorporated into the West
7 Pilot’s collective bargaining agreement.” The Motion to Amend is **DENIED** to the extent
8 it seeks additional relief.
